

**Block Entry Credits (Advanced Standing) of Education Studies (ES) Courses in Part-time Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Primary/ Secondary) Programmes (for 2025/26 cohort)****For Graduates of City University of Hong Kong with Minor in Education Studies  
(under the Academic Collaboration Scheme with City University of Hong Kong)**

CityU students who have successfully completed the Minor in Education Studies in EdUHK are eligible for the Block Entry Credits (Advanced Standing) upon admission to the Part-time PGDE(P)/(S) programme in 2025/26, provided that:

- 1) The related Minor in Education Studies (ES) courses should be taken within eight years prior to the year of admission to the Part-time PGDE(P)/(S) programme (i.e. from the completion year of Minor in ES offered to CityU students up to the admission year of PT PGDE(P/S)); and
- 2) The total number of credit points transferred should not exceed 50% of the total credit points required by the respective PGDE(P)/(S) programme.

CityU graduates who had completed the Minor in Education Studies (i.e. taken 5 out of 6 courses) in or after 2013/14 cohort are eligible for the Block Entry Credits (Advanced Standing) for three Education Studies courses (9 cps in total) in Part-time PGDE(P)/(S) programme as follows:
