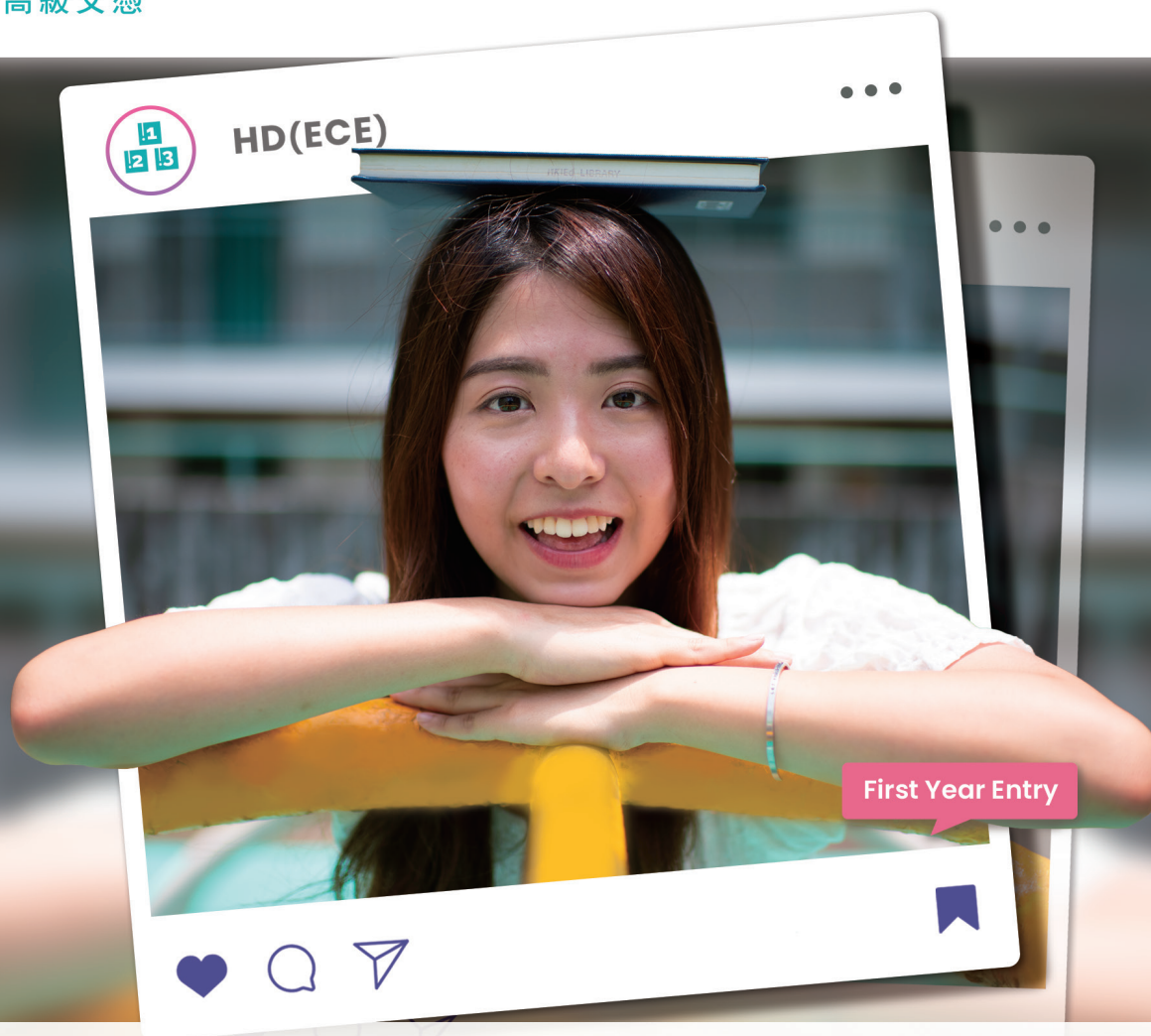

- Graduates are eligible to apply to become Qualified Kindergarten Teachers and Registered Child Care Workers, and possess the professional qualification required of all child care supervisors
- Graduates are recognised as having acquired training on the One-year In-service Course in Special Child Care Work of the Social Welfare Department
- Students can earn a higher diploma, a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in just five years
- The EdUHK offers a variety of undergraduate programmes for students to choose from, including full-time senior year entry programmes, and part-time top-up programmes

Streams of Study

The Programme will offer two streams of study in the 2023/24 academic year:

- Chinese as the Medium of Instruction [CMI] - The medium of instruction is mainly Chinese. English will be adopted as the language of instruction for specific courses, as deemed appropriate
- English as the Medium of Instruction [EMI] - The medium of instruction is mainly English

Students will be given the opportunity to choose either the CMI or the EMI stream upon admission to the Programme. The final allocation of students to the CMI or EMI stream will be decided by the University.

General Admission Requirements #

Applicants are normally required to possess Level 2 or above in five HKDSE subjects. These should include Chinese Language and English Language (not more than two Applied Learning subjects).

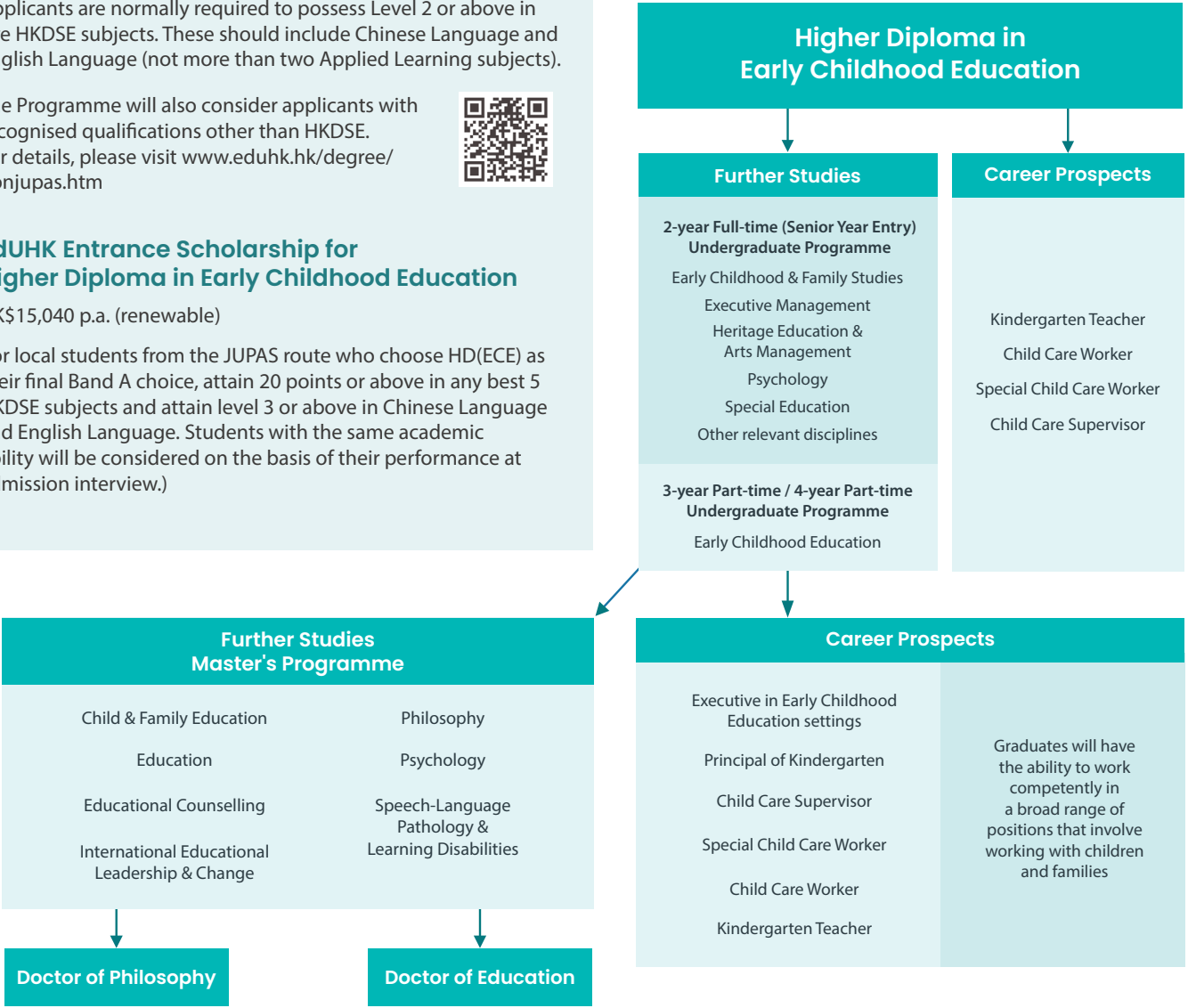


EdUHK Entrance Scholarship for Higher Diploma in Early Childhood Education

Students with the same academic ability will be considered on the basis of their performance at admission interview.)

All applications will be assessed by the EDB which will consider, among other things, whether an applicant has been convicted of any criminal offence (including sex-related offences) in Hong Kong or elsewhere, or is involved in any ongoing criminal proceedings or investigations.
