香港的社會企業現狀

根據民政事務總署的定義,社金「是一盤生 意,宗旨是要達致特定的社會目的」。經過20 年的發展,香港的社企業界已經初具規模。截 至目前,社會企業商務中心共記錄了近700間 社會企業;這些社企遍佈全港各區、涵蓋文化 藝術、環境保護、飲食家居、教育培訓等各類 業務性質,爲達至扶貧、社區共融、可持續發 展等多方面的社會目的。自2008年開始,社 企業界每年都會舉辦「社企民間高峰會」,旨 在向全社會倡導社會企業家精神,並培育青年 一代的創新意識與能力。「香港社會企業挑戰 賽」也是香港社企業界每年的一大盛事,目的 是爲全港大專院校學生提供社企創業的訓練和 比赛平台;2007年至今,社企挑戰賽已經成 功舉辦了15年,共吸引了8842名來自129間 大專院校的參賽者,累積了1573個企業計劃。

有利的政策支持 成就最佳的青年創業時代

特區政府青年發展委員會於2018年推出了 「青年共享空間計劃」,邀請工度或商度的業 主以優惠租金為青年提供工作空間或創作室, 協助那些從事創意產業、創新科技及文藝工作 的青年。目前,已投入服務的共享空間共有 13處,這為青年創業活動提供了最基本的「硬 體」保障。青年發展委員會還成立了「青年發




Minor in Public Policy and Management



- a) Graduates of Associate Degree / Higher Diploma from a recognized institutions with a good GPA; or
- b) Final year students of a recognised Associate Degree/Higher Diploma programme or equivalent* (subject to successful completion of the programme by August with a good GPA)
- c) Transfer students who are currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or higher degree programme (considered on an individual basis)

- 1. Fulfil one of the following **English language** requirements:
 - Level 3 or above in HKDSE English Language; or
 - Level 2 or above in HKDSE English Language (applicable to holders of recognised AD/HD); or


