(1) [For Year 1 Admissions only] Students admitted into this programme are required to participate in the Regional Summer Institute (RSI) and contribute 18% of the estimated cost of the RSI in order to complete the programme.

(2) [For Year 1 Admissions only] Students admitted into this programme starting from the 2023/24 cohort are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) for a short trip (e.g. 1-day or 2-day 1-night trip) in order to complete the Cross-Faculty Core Course. While the GBA trip is heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute 18% of the estimated cost of the trip ("student contribution"), whereas personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs will not be supported. The estimated cost of the GBA trip as a result of inflation, trip duration, traveling expenses, the exchange rate, etc. The exact amount of student contribution is thus not available.

Any aspect of the course and course offerings (including, without limitation, the content of the course and the manner in which the course is taught) may be subject to change at any time at the sole discretion of the University. 


## Admission Requirements for Associate Degree (AD)/ Higher Diploma (HD) Students or Graduates

#### Non-JUPAS applicants

- Both AD/HD non-final year and final year students will be considered for admission.
- AD/HD holders with good final GPA will be considered for admission to senior years.
- Good interview results required.
- The programme reserves a number of Senior Year (i.e. Year 3) places for quality students holding AD/HD (or equivalent) qualifications. Admitted students are only required to take 60 credit points (cps) and can complete the programme in two years.

# Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Creative Arts and Culture and Bachelor of Education (Honours) (MUSIC)/(VISUAL ARTS)

#### (Five-year Full-time) (Co-terminal Double Degree)

The 5-year Full-time Co-terminal Double Degree programmes aims to prepare professional Music/Visual Arts teachers and community-based artists. The programme is not only devoted to preparing qualified, competent, professional primary/secondary school teachers capable of satisfying the educational needs of learners with different abilities in a community, but also committed to nurturing community arts and cultural workers who values multiple aspects of intelligence. Graduates of the programme will have attained academic excellence and professional competence, and will possess a solid command of subject knowledge and skills in their chosen disciplines together with a firm and thorough grasp of the interrelationship between theory and practice. They will be creative, responsible, and caring individuals who have an understanding of the arts, culture, community and society, and have a commitment to moral values and lifelong learning.



#### PROGRAMME AIMS

- To prepare professional Music / Visual Arts teachers and community-based artists who can demonstrate a solid foundation in Music/Visual Arts skills, related academic competencies and teaching practices to meet their future teaching needs; and
- To enable graduates to work across a range of established art forms and contribute to the promotion and development of the arts and arts education in the local, regional and international cultural and creative industries.



#### Students will be able to

- integrate subject knowledge, professional knowledge and practical abilities in Education Major and Discipline Major;
- participate in school field experience to further enhance academic knowledge, professional skills and practical approaches;
- have first-hand exposure to the operations of an organisation and reflect on the practices in the real working environment in the work-based internship experience;
- take part in the student exchange programmes and study tours to broaden their international horizon; and
- · obtain a double degree upon completion of all graduation requirements.

#### CAREER PROSPECTS

#### Graduates of the programme

· will possess a Qualified Teacher Status in Hong Kong with in-depth academic and professional knowledge;

· will be qualified for teaching career opportunities in primary or secondary schools in Hong Kong;\*

 will obtain the ability to work competently in a broad range of positions such as curators for art museums and galleries, administrators of arts-and-cultural related organisations, researchers in cultural studies, musicians/designers and arts educators; and

· can pursue local and overseas higher degree level programmes in education and creative arts disciplines.

\* Students admitted into this programme are normally assigned a focus of study (i.e. primary or secondary level) by the end of their first year of study. The focus of study will be reflected in the arrangements for their Field Experience and adopted for the purpose of application for Qualified Teacher Status in Hong Kong upon graduation. This programme is designed to provide students with the disciplinary and professional competency to teach in both primary and secondary schools. However, recognition of Qualified Teaching Status (QTS) in primary or secondary schools in Hong Kong is subject to the decision of the Education Bureau (EDB). Graduates of this programme are required to approach the Teacher Registration Section of the EDB to submit applications directly and all applications will be assessed by the EDB.



### General Entrance Requirements for students with HKDSE qualifications:

4 core subjects and 1 elective subject with

- Level 3 or above in English Language and Chinese Language; and
- Level 2 or above in Mathematics (Compulsory Part), Liberal Studies and 1 elective subject

#### **Programme Entrance Requirements:**

 Satisfactory performance in a practical test / an audition# and a portfolio interview, in addition to the General **Entrance Requirements** 

\*Applicants who do not take HKDSE Music/Visual Arts; or obtain Level 3 or below in HKDSE will need to attend the practical test / participate in the audition. Applicants who obtain Level 4 or above will be exempted from the test/audition.

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EdUHK is one of the teacher education providers in Hong Kong. Graduates of the University's teacher education programmes are eligible to apply to become fully qualified and registered teachers. As regards teacher registration, graduates should approach the Teacher Registration Team of the Education Bureau (EDB) to submit applications directly. All applications will be assessed by the EDB which will consider, among other things, whether an applicant has been convicted of any criminal offence (including sex-related offences) in Hong Kong or elsewhere, or is involved in any ongoing criminal proceedings or investigations.

Students admitted into this programme starting from the 2023/24 cohort are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) for a short trip (e.g. 1-day or 2-day 1-night trip) in order to complete the Cross-Faculty Core Course. While the GBA trip is heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute 18% of the estimated cost of the trip ("student contribution"), whereas personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs will not be supported. 



#### 梁寶華教授 文化與創意藝術學系 教授

梁寶華教授現任香港教育大學文化與創意藝術學系教授,及粵劇傳承研究中心總監。其領導的研究計劃「中小學粵劇教學協作計劃」,先後於2011年獲國際音樂議會頒發音樂權益獎及2012年獲教大頒發知識轉移獎。梁教授曾於多份國際知名學術期刊發表研究論文及編撰多部著作,曾獲三次香港研究資助局之優配研究金及兩次優質教育基金以資助其研究。梁教授現任國際音樂教育學會主席、亞太音樂教育研究論壇主席、亞太藝術教育學報總編輯、香港學術及職業資歷評審局教育及演藝學科專家、教育局香港卓越獎學金計劃面試小組委員、香港演藝學院中國戲曲學院顧問、及音樂事務處專業顧問。

#### 何崇志博士 文化與創意藝術學系 助理教授

何崇志出生於香港,在加拿大英屬哥倫比亞大學獲取音樂藝術博士學位。深造期間,多次在加拿大全國作曲比賽中獲獎,包括PROCAN 1987及CAPAC 1988。在2002年,何氏為電影《麥兜故事》所創作的音樂獲香港電影金像獎最佳電影音樂之殊榮,随後他再為《麥兜菠蘿油王子》、《春田花花同學會》、《麥兜吶噹噹》及《麥兜·飯寶奇兵》等多齣電影創作配樂。另外,何氏創作之大型合唱作品《宇宙的山歌》榮獲2005年度香港作曲及作詞家協會本地正統音樂最廣泛演出「金帆獎」,而於2015年度金馬獎中榮獲最佳動畫的《麥兜·我和我媽媽》之電影配樂亦是出自他的手筆。何氏一向熱愛以廣東話譜寫合唱歌曲,其作品數量過百,受到廣泛演出。何氏亦致力推動原創歌舞劇,大都充滿香港色彩,而他最新的歌劇《歌王之王》更獲選入2021年香港電台主辦的十大樂聞之一。在國際,何氏多次應邀為多個音樂節撰寫樂章,擔任評委及講座,包括加拿大The Pacific Piano Competition、加拿大CFMTA's Musical Odyssey、瑞士World Choral Symposium、法國 Polyfollia及丹麥Song Bridge Festival,世界青少年合唱節等。何氏現任職於香港教育大學,為其當代音樂及演奏教育學課程主任及助理教授,並委任為華南師範大學客座教。

#### **EdUHK Undergraduate Programme Nominations Scheme**

香港教育大學學士課程提名機制

The EdUHK Undergraduate Programme Nominations Scheme aims to attract young talent who aspire to develop their potential to the full and serve our school community. This scheme is different from the School Principal's Nominations (SPN) Scheme under JUPAS. Applicants may apply for both schemes in their JUPAS application.

#### **Eligibility:**

- The respective programme(s) of music must be put as Band A choice(s) in JUPAS; and
- Nominees must demonstrate a high performance standard in music with relevant qualifications, experiences and achievements. Recommendation letter from school teacher(s) or principal is preferable. (Possession of qualifications, awards and achievements in other creative arts such as dance, visual arts etc. will be considered as an advantage for BA(CAC) applicants.)
- For the EdUHK Undergraduate Programme Nominations Scheme, application can only be lodged through a direct recommendation from school principal. In addition, the nominees must have been rated "excellent" or "good" in ALL of the 13 attributes in the School Reference Report.
