Programme Structure (For Year-1 Admission)

Important Notes:

- 1. Classes will be held in Tai Po Campus and Tseung Kwan O Study Centre / North Point Study Centre / Sports Centre as decided by the University.
- 2. Students admitted into this programme starting from the 2023/24 cohort are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Mainland China. Programme may also require students to participate in other non-local learning experience for completion of the programme. While the visits are heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute part of the estimated cost of the visits ("student contribution"), whereas personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs will not be supported. The estimated cost of the visits for students admitted to the 2024/25 cohort is not available yet as it is subject to a variety of factors such as changes to the cost of the visits as a result of inflation, trip duration, traveling expenses, the exchange rate, etc. The exact amount of student contribution is thus not available.










Entrance Requirements & Interview Tips

Entrance Requirements (JUPAS)

Year 1 Admissions (JUPAS)

For students with HKDSE qualifications:

Four core subjects and two elective subjects with

- 1. Level 3 or above in English Language and Chinese Language; and
- 2. Level 2 or above in Mathematics (Compulsory Part); and
- 3. Attained result in Citizenship and Social Development; and
- 4. Level 2 or above in two elective subjects, preferably in Biology or Physical Education.

Applicants who have not taken Biology or Physical Education in HKDSE will still be considered.

But priority consideration will be given to applicants who have taken Biology or Physical Education in HKDSE.

Eligible applicants will be invited for the interview which will be conducted in English and Chinese.





Admission Score Calculation

Year 1 Admissions (JUPAS)

The admission score is the sum total of the level/grade values of the best five HKDSE subjects (i.e., Best 5), regardless of whether they are core or elective subjects and excluding the Citizenship and Social Development subject.

Interview Tips

Applicants are recommended to

- Make a comprehensive study/research on the curriculum and the career paths
 of BSc(SPSC) programme;
- 2. Put all the key messages e.g., sports background, the highest sports achievement, the reasons why you choose this programme and why you think you are the most suitable candidate for this programme, into 2-minute self-introduction;
- 3. Get yourself familiar with the latest development of the sports that you are interested in e.g., FIFA 11+ programme for football players;
- 4. Listen carefully to the question and don't be afraid to take some time to think about your answer or ask interviewers to repeat it:
- 5. Stay clam when you are being challenged;
- 6. Be yourself, genuine and authentic; and
- 7. Do more mock interviews.



O5 Nomination Schemes & Important Dates

EdUHK Self-Nomination Admissions Scheme

Background

The EdUHK Self-Nomination Admissions Scheme is designed for JUPAS applicants with exceptional potential and outstanding talent in music, sports, STEM or visual arts. Applicants can submit their self-nominations to the related JUPAS programmes of the University.

Applicants shortlisted by the respective subject departments will be interviewed in February or June. Students with excellent performance in the interview(s) will be given priority of admission, if deemed appropriate.

- Bachelor of Education (Honours) (Physical Education) (Five-year Full-time) (JS8325)
- Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Sports Science and Coaching (Four-year Full-time) (JS8726)

Eligibility

- 1. Put the relevant programme(s) as Band A choice in JUPAS application;
- 2. Demonstrate high sports performance standard in a major sport, such as:
 - Elite athlete in the Hong Kong Sports Institute
 - Current/former Hong Kong National Squad member
 - Current Hong Kong Junior Squad member
 - Outstanding Student athlete in the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation
 - Outstanding Student athlete in the University Sports Federation of Hong Kong
- 3. Recommended by Hong Kong Sports Institute, Sports Federation and Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, or other National Sports Associations/ Schools.

EdUHK Nomination Scheme For Elite Athletes

Background

To offer more options and flexibility for elite athletes to enroll in the EdUHK's undergraduate programmes, the University has launched the EdUHK Nomination Scheme for Elite Athletes (NSEA) since the 2022/23 academic year. The University can also take this opportunity to contribute to the sports development in Hong Kong by supporting young athletes and recognizing their achievements.

Features

- Available for both JUPAS and Non-JUPAS local applicants;
- Applicable for ALL UGC-funded Undergraduate Programmes of EdUHK;
- Eligible applicants will be invited to attend the interview and/or test;
- Outstanding applicants will be given high priority / conditional offer of admission to the chosen programme.
- Successful applicants admitted via NSEA will be considered automatically by the Student-Athlete Learning Support and Admission Scheme (SALSA Scheme). Please click here for details.

Eligibility

- 1. Elite athletes nominated by the following two institutions will be considered for admission by EdUHK:
 - a. Hong Kong Sports Institute (HKSI)
 - b. Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China (SF&OC)
- 2. Nominations of elite athletes from other recognized sports associations/institutions may also be considered on a case-by-case basis;
- 3. Nominees should attain individual/team achievements in sports (through participation and/or winning of medals) at recognized sports competitions at the international, regional and/or national level; and
- 4. Nominees should be JUPAS or non-JUPAS applicants applying for admission to the UGC-funded undergraduate programmes of EdUHK.

EdUHK Nomination Scheme For Elite Athletes

Nomination

The main round nomination period run from early October to 31 December 2023. Nominations after main round will be accepted on a rolling basis. Eligible nominees will be notified of the interview and/or test arrangement by email.

— For JUPAS applicants:

- 1. Submit JUPAS application and place the chosen programme as a Band A Choice;
- 2. Submit the Online Nomination Form and upload all relevant supporting documents* including:
 - Proof(s) of the sports achievements;
 - A personal statement (300-500 words) to explain why you would like to study the chosen programme and outline your future aspirations after graduating from the programme; and
 - Recommendation letters from the school principal (if available) and HKSI / SF&OC / other recognized sports institutions.

— For Non-JUPAS applicants:

- 1. Submit direct application for the chosen programme via EdUHK Online Application Systems including proof(s) of academic qualifications;
- 2. Submit the Online Nomination Form and upload all relevant supporting documents* including:
 - Proof(s) of the sports achievements;
 - A personal statement (300-500 words) to explain why you would like to study the chosen programme and outline your future aspirations after graduating from the programme; and
 - Recommendation letters from the school principal (if available) and HKSI / SF&OC / other recognized sports institutions.


