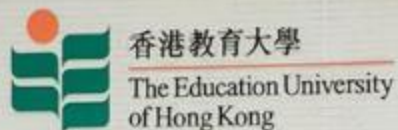

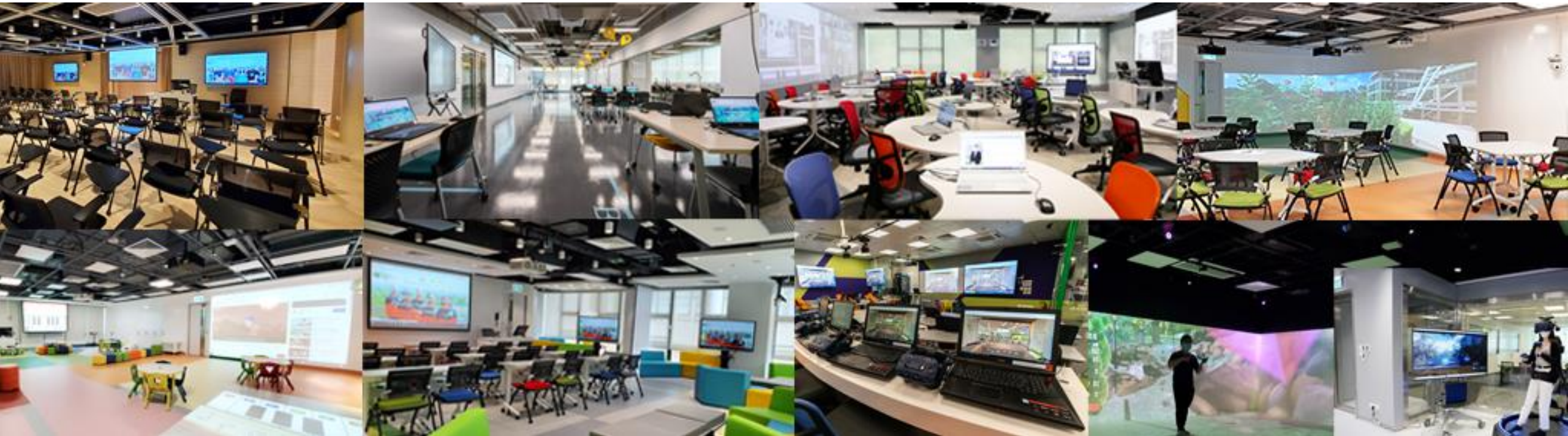

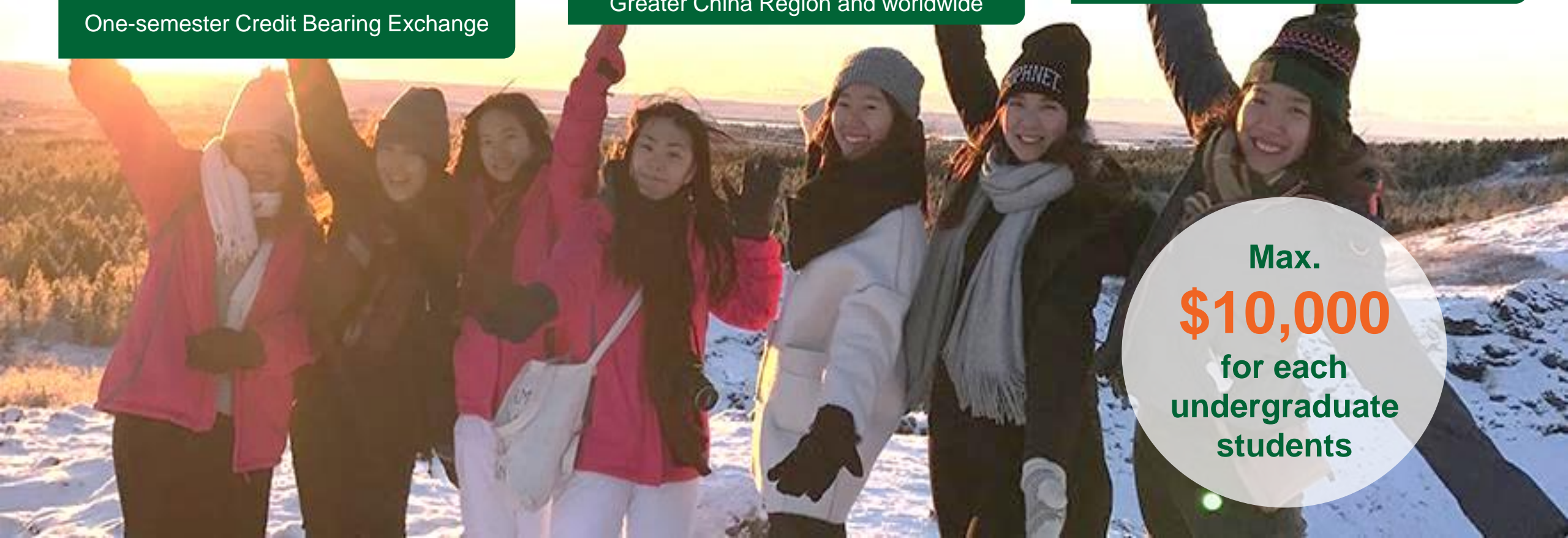

General Entrance Requirements (Remarks)

For Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) applicants, the University accepts **Alternative Qualifications in Chinese Language**, such as GCE (A-level / AS-level) (Grade E), GCE (O-Level) (Grade C), GCSE (Grade C / Grade 4), IGCSE (Grade C / Grade 4) and HKDSE ApL(C) (Attained), as **equivalent to Level 3 in DSE Chinese Language** for meeting the minimum Chinese Language requirements and for calculation of the related admission scores, except for programmes which require students to have possessed a good command of Chinese.

"**Combined sittings**" is accepted for meeting the General Entrance Requirements and for the calculation of admission scores. If an applicant has taken the HKDSE examination in a subject more than once, the best result for that subject will be counted. There is no score deduction for repeated subjects.

Flexible Admission may be adopted for Band A applicants who fail to meet the general entrance requirements by one level in one of the HKDSE core subjects, but achieve excellent result(s) in the HKDSE subject(s) relevant to the applied programme(s). Suitable candidates will be invited for admission interview.



Flexible Admission

On Competitive Basis

- Outstanding **achievements / performance** in PE, Music, Visual Arts, STEM related subjects, Chinese and English
- Core subjects – **one level below** in one subject (excluding CSD)
- **Band A** – suitable candidates will be invited for interview
- Good performance in **admission interview**
- Limited quota

Scholarships

EdUHK Entrance Scholarship

Local Students

- Full Scholarship: HK\$90,000 p.a. (highest score)
- Tuition Scholarship: HK\$42,100 p.a.
(sum of best 5 score ≥ 24 , Chinese and English ≥ 4 and 5)
- Half-tuition Scholarship for NCS students: HK\$21,050 p.a.
(sum of best 5 score ≥ 20)
- Tuition Scholarship for HD(ECE) students: HK\$15,040 p.a.

Non-local Students

- Full Scholarship: HK\$185,000 p.a.
- Tuition Scholarship: HK\$140,000 p.a.
- Half-tuition Scholarship: HK\$70,000 p.a.

Faculty-level Admission Scholarships

One-off scholarship: HK\$15,000 – 20,000

(on the basis of academic merit in public examinations, interview performance and/or other academic qualifications)

- Successful nominee will receive firm offer before the release of HKDSE results
- **Nomination deadline: 6 Dec 2023**

EdUHK Nomination Scheme for Elite Athletes (NSEA)

- Available for Elite Athletes through both JUPAS and non-JUPAS applicants
- **Nomination deadline: 31 Dec 2023 (1st round)**

EdUHK Undergraduate Programme Nominations Scheme (UPNS)

- For schools to nominate students who:
 - aspire to develop their potential to the full and serve our school community
 - made outstanding achievements in non-academic areas such as sports, music, social services, other cultural activities
 - have demonstrated leadership abilities
- **Nomination deadline: 22 Mar 2024**

JUPAS School Principal's Nominations (SPN)

- For students who have contributed to social services or made outstanding achievements in non-academic areas
- **Nomination deadline: 16 May 2024**

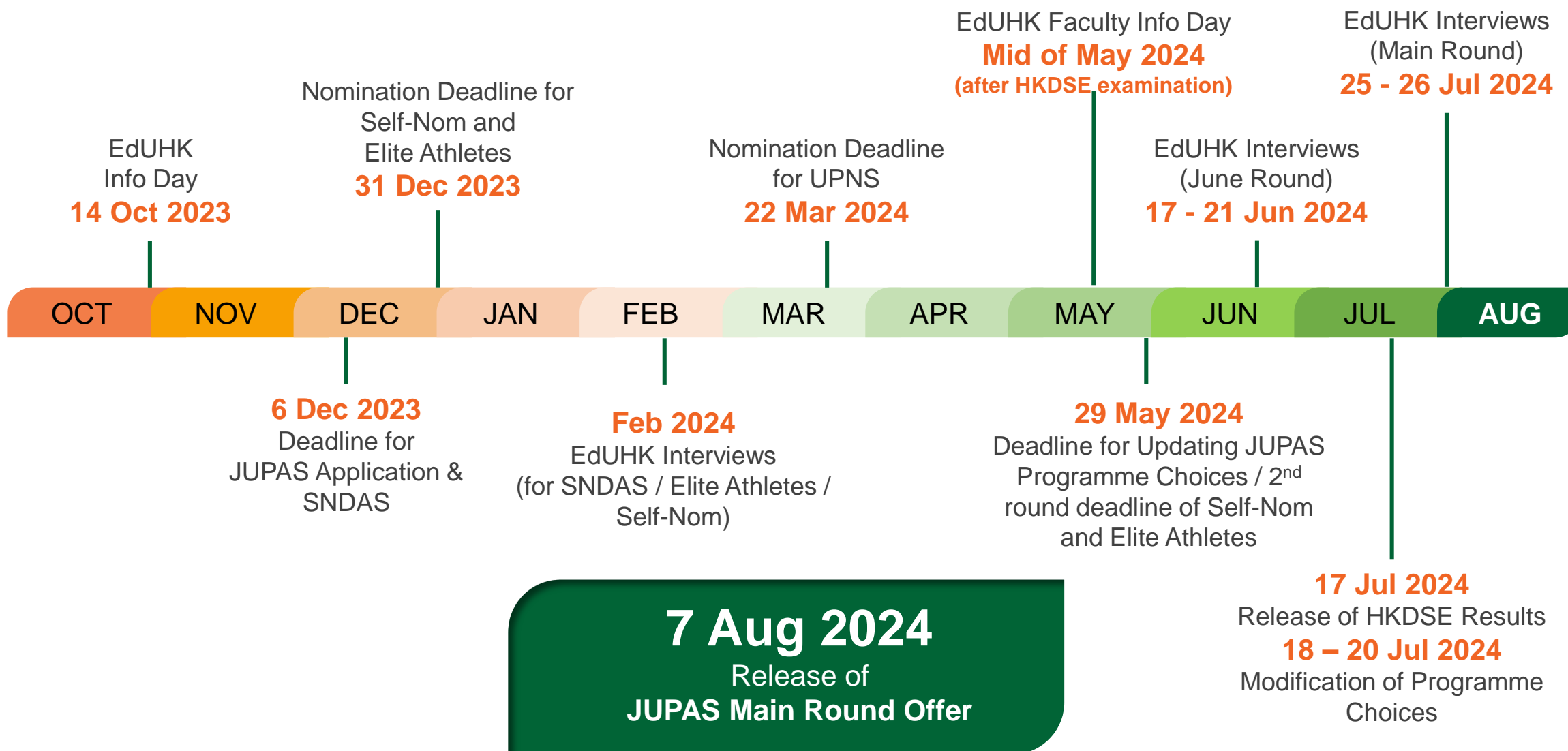
EdUHK Self-Nomination Admissions Scheme

- Utilize 20 programme choices

- Band A applicants may be invited on selective basis

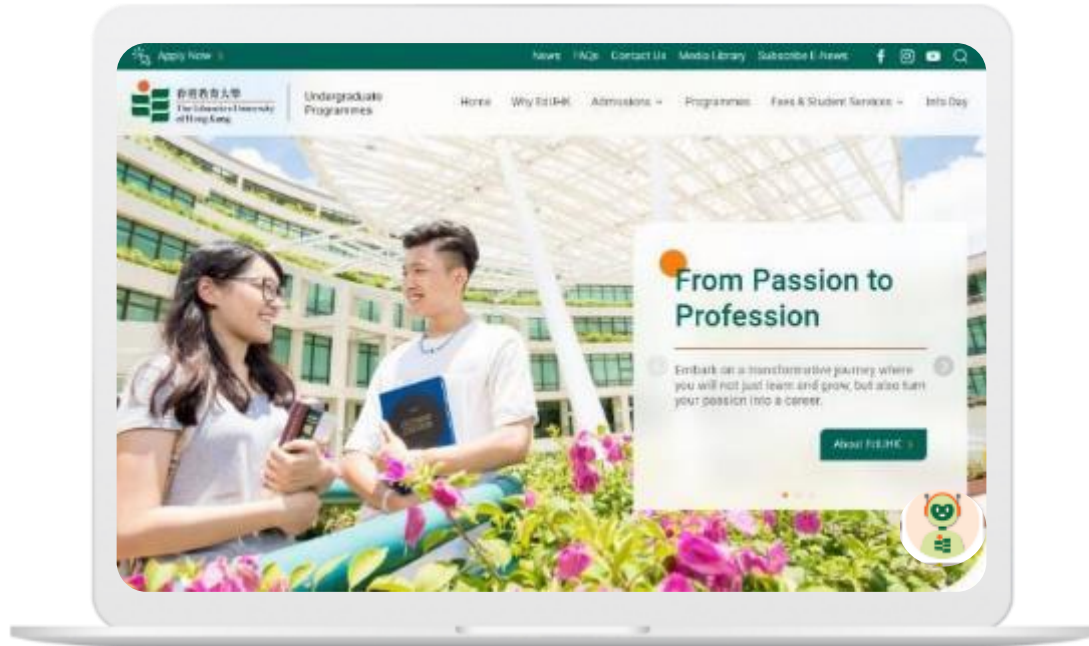

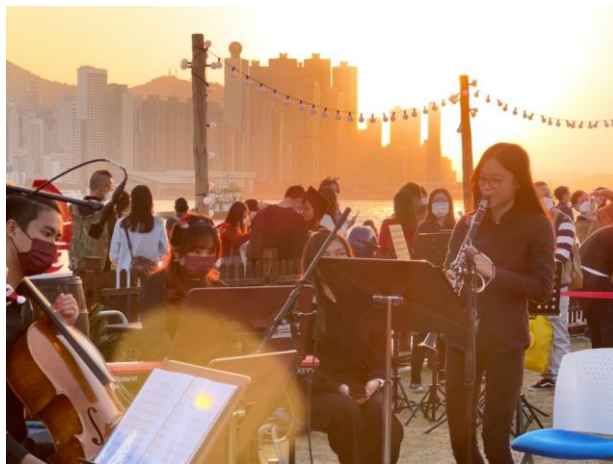
