Internship

- The Internship is a 3-cp / 6-cp compulsory experiential and professional component of the programmes normally held in the first summer break.
- Students will work as an intern in an organisation in Hong Kong, Greater Bay Area, or overseas in the field related to their studies, where they can further cultivate skills and knowledge developed in the programme.
- It aims to provide students with real-life working experiences linked to their career.



BA (Hon) in Creative Arts and Culture – Music / Visual Arts



This BA(CAC) programme is the first undergraduate programme in Hong Kong to **offer arts management and cultural studies** to complement discipline-based training in the creative arts.

It aims to develop **Community-Based Artists (CBA)** who are able to work across a range of established art forms and contribute to the promotion and development of the arts and arts education in the local, regional and international cultural and creative industries.

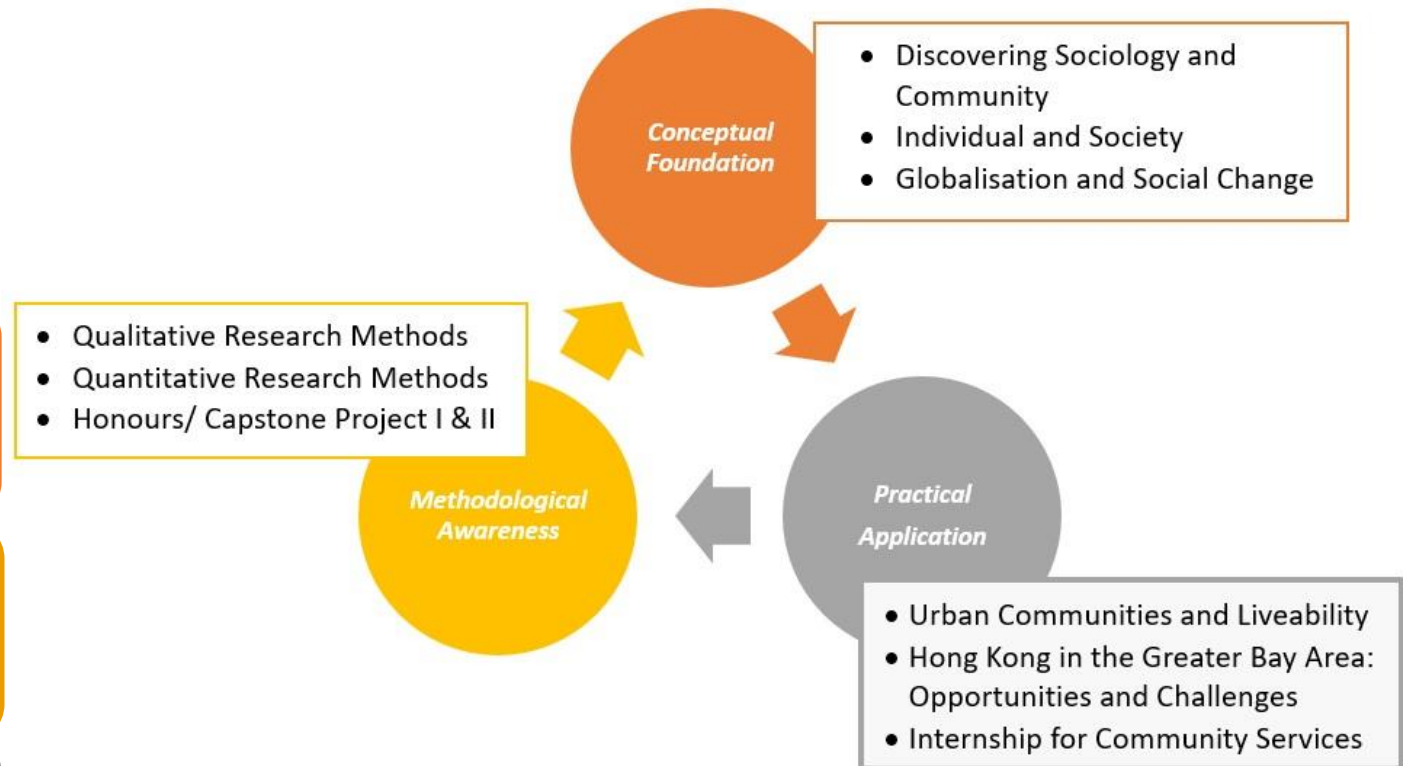

The BA(Lang Studies) programme aims to nurture graduates with the following attributes:

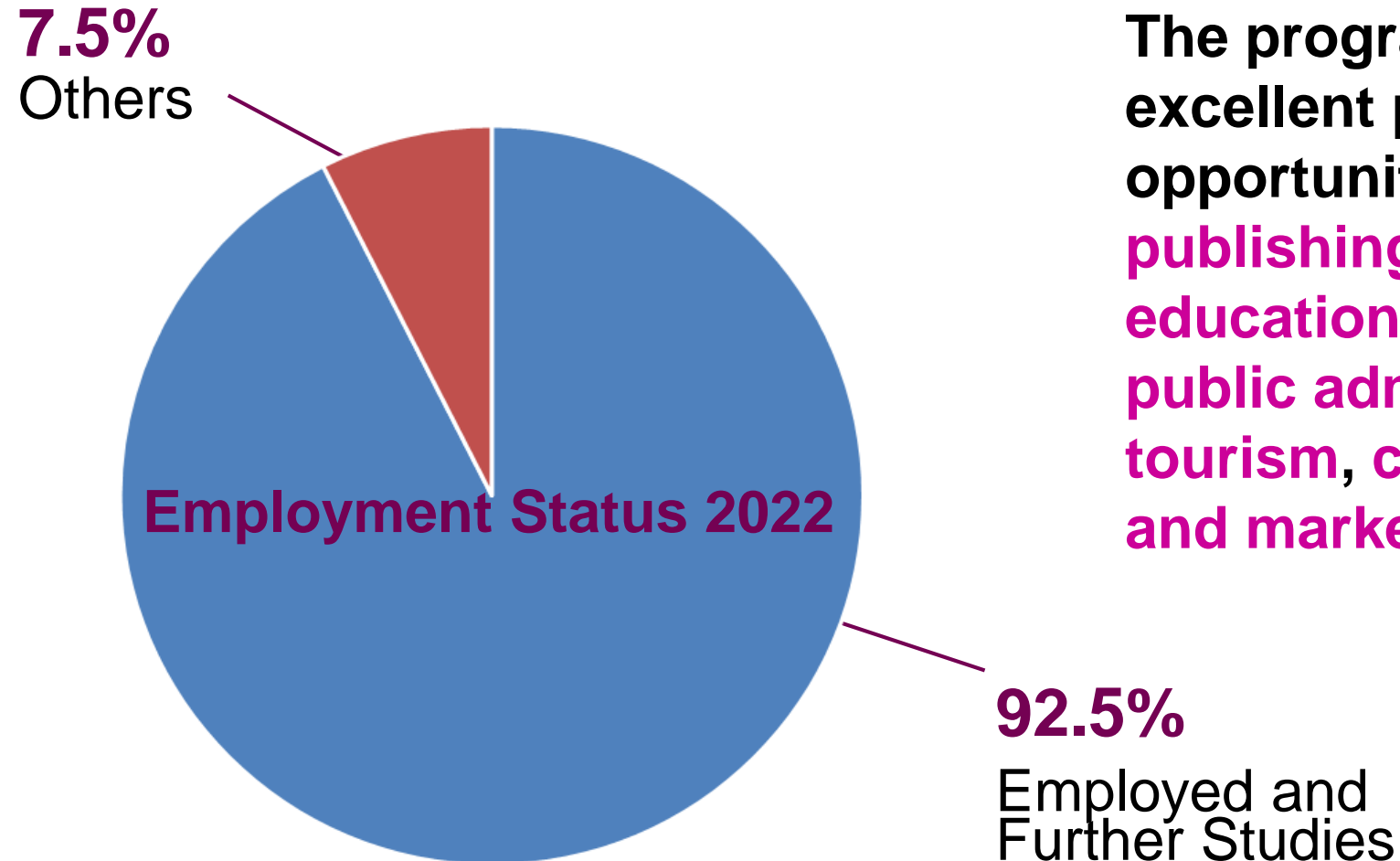
- Demonstrate a **high level of proficiency** in the language of their major;

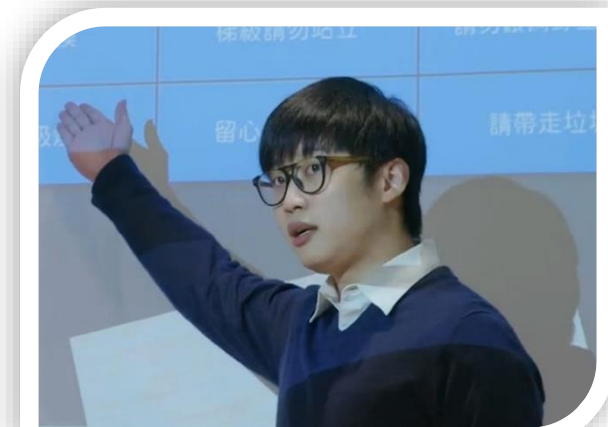

Programme Features

- BA(TCSL) aims to nurture professionals in teaching Chinese as a second language. Students enrolled into the programme will be equipped with
 - **Interdisciplinary knowledge** including Chinese language and pedagogy, as well as educational psychology; and
 - The ability to analyse issues related to **Chinese teaching** in the context of multilingualism and globalisation.
- It is **the first and only undergraduate programme** in Hong Kong to specialise in the field of teaching Chinese as an international language.



Chinese Language Strand

- The BA(TCSL) programme offers a “Chinese Language Strand” to its senior year entrants.
- Students taking this Strand are required to use the **15 cps** under the Elective domain to study specified Elective courses.
- Students who successfully graduate with this Strand will **be recognised by Standing Committee on Language Education and Research (SCOLAR/語常會)** as graduates of a Chinese major degree. They can further **apply for local Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE)** programmes.

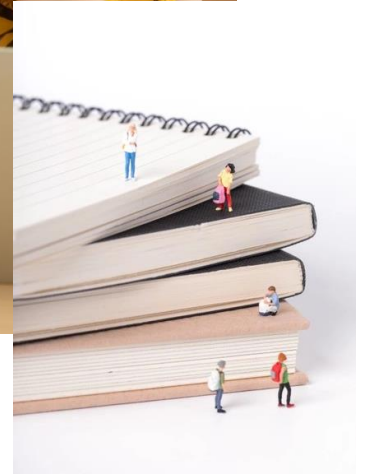
