Programme Aims

This programme aims to prepare graduates to become competent physical education teachers who:

- demonstrate academic competence in disciplinary knowledge of humanities and science of human movement appropriate for teaching of PE in Hong Kong secondary and primary schools;
- apply theories into practice innovatively to serve as professional PE teachers facilitating pupils' informed and active learning in Hong Kong secondary and primary schools;
- · value and understand critical sports-related values and attitudes;
- demonstrate critical understanding of curricular and pedagogical knowledge and skills appropriate for teaching of PE in Hong Kong secondary and primary schools;
- master and value a variety of physical activities as well as participate regularly in contributing to healthy and active lifestyles;
- engage in on-going enrichment in professional and intellectual development concerning PE.



Entrance Requirements

JUPAS applicants should have :

- Level 3 or above in English Language and Chinese Language; and
- Level 2 or above in Mathematics (Compulsory Part); and
- Attained level for Citizenship and Social Development ; and Level 2 or above in any two electives subjects.

Statement

Students admitted into this programme starting from the 2023/24 cohort are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Mainland China. Programme may also require students to participate in other nonlocal learning experience for completion of the programme. While the visits are heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute part of the estimated cost of the visits ("student contribution"), whereas personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs will not be supported. The estimated cost of the visits for students admitted to the 2024/25 cohort is not available yet as it is subject to a variety of factors such as changes to the cost of the visits as a result of inflation, trip duration, traveling expenses, the exchange rate, etc. The exact amount of student contribution is thus not available.

Students admitted into this programme are normally assigned a focus of study (i.e. primary or secondary level) by the end of their first year of study. The focus of study will be reflected in the arrangements for their Field Experience and adopted for the purpose of application for Qualified Teacher Status in Hong Kong upon graduation. This programme is designed to provide students with the disciplinary and professional competency to teach in both primary and secondary schools. However, recognition of Qualified Teaching Status (QTS) in primary or secondary schools in Hong Kong is subject to the decision of the Education Bureau (EDB). Graduates of this programme are required to approach the Teacher Registration Team of the EDB to submit applications directly and all applications will be assessed by the EDB.

Important Note: Students should possess certain Physical Education for Children with Special Needs ball games, gymnastics, swimming, racketgames and dance, etc.



Field Experience

Students can integrate both theories and experiences in the actual teaching environment in school field experience (including class observation and teaching practices)

Career Prospects/Professional Qualifications

As stipulated by the Government, Physical Education can only be taught by fully qualified professionals. This has created a huge demand for professionally trained Physical Education teachers in Hong Kong. In addition, graduates of the programme can also choose to become professional coaches, sports management personnel and officers of local disciplinary forces.

CODE OF A MERSING STREET, MARKENING

Graduates of the programme will become competent teachers of Physical Education with the following skills and qualifications:

- Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) in primary or secondary schools in Hong Kong subject to the decision of the Education Bureau (EDB);
- Good foundation in sports, humanities, science, pedagogy and curriculum disciplines for further studies; and
- Degree-level professional qualifications that are in great demand in the Physical Education related professions.
